No one in my immediate family or friend group was breastfeeding at the time and it was a big adjustment but one of the greatest joys of my life. I felt I didn't have much support from friends or family to encourage my journey and at times it did feel lonely. Thankfully second time around it was better and even more so in my 3rd. This is why I would love to be there for any other moth- er who may feel lonely or just need a little encouragement or advice.	I am a mother of three children. I experienced lots of issues feeding my first daughter and found supports difficult to find and access. After a tongue tie release, things improved but were never fully corrected. I fed her until she was 12 months. I had a very different experience with my 2nd and 3rd babies. Was lucky to find a knowledgeable and supportive G.P and then a support group. Had wonderful experiences feeding my son to 14 months and my daughter until she self-weaned at 19 months. I have first hand experience of how support can positively and completely change breastfeeding outcomes.
