ABOUT THE CENTRE



The HSE vaccination centre for Clifden is operating from Clifden Community School. This is a satellite centre and is open for one or two days per week depending on demand and vaccine supply. A helpline has been set up for people to request to have their second dose of vaccine in Clifden, call 086 036 0942 between 10am and 2pm, Monday to Friday.

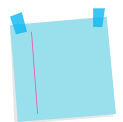

BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT



- You will receive an invitation for your vaccine appointment by text message (SMS)
- The message will indicate the time, date and location of your appointment
- Please bring your PPS number and photo ID (e.g. passport, driving licence / Public Services Card). You will not receive a vaccine without photo ID
- If you are coming for a second dose of vaccine bring your vaccination record card
- You should wear a loose fitting or short sleeved top as the vaccine will be administered to your upper arm
- Plan to arrive 10 minutes before your appointment and wait in your car until 5 minutes before your appointment
- Please dress for the weather as you may need to queue outside

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



- Wear a mask when you arrive and for the duration of the appointment
- Enter the site through main entrance on the Ballyconeely Road, the vaccination centre is located in the hall to the rear of the school
- Park your car and make your way to the hall, disabled parking spaces are available for permit holders
- There may be a queue outside the entrance, please ensure physical distancing of 2m if queueing
- Before you enter the building security staff will ask some COVID-19 screening questions and confirm your appointment. They will also check your photo ID
- If you have travelled with a companion, they should remain in the car unless they need to attend with you in exceptional circumstances

INSIDE THE CENTRE



- Please use hand sanitiser located at the entrance
- When it's your turn, go inside the building you will be directed to a reception desk to check in
- Reception staff will confirm your appointment, your name, date of birth and your PPS number
- You will then be directed to a booth to receive your vaccine
- A vaccinator will be waiting for you inside the booth
- The vaccinator will ask you some questions to confirm your eligibility for a vaccine and will administer your vaccine to your upper arm
- You will be given your vaccination record and will be asked to take a seat in the observation area for 15 minutes
- You should keep the vaccination record safe as you will need to bring it with you if you require a second vaccination appointment
- Once the 15 minutes have passed you can leave the observation area via the exit door at the back of the hall
